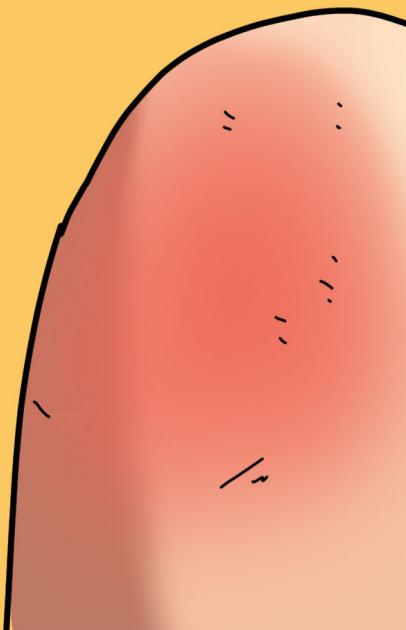


1st 2nd and 3rd Degree Burn Examples

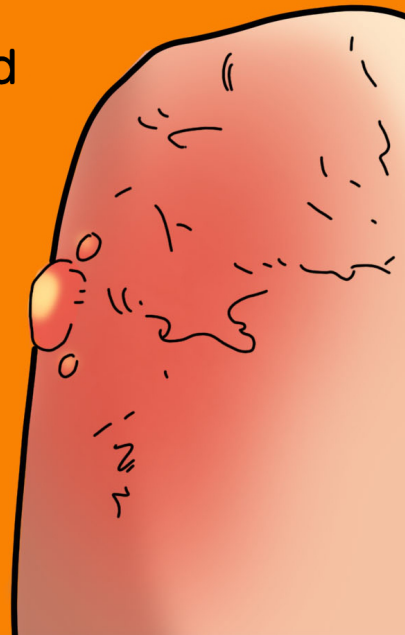
1st degree

- red
- painful
- dry
- no blisters



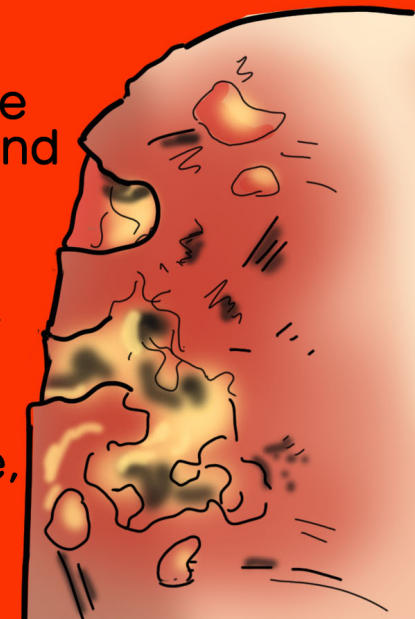
2nd degree

- involves the epidermis and dermis
- red and blistered
- may be swollen and painful



3rd degree

- swollen
- destroys the epidermis and the layer beneath
- can appear dry and leathery, black, white, brown, or yellow
